This ship was owned by Joseph Rotch.

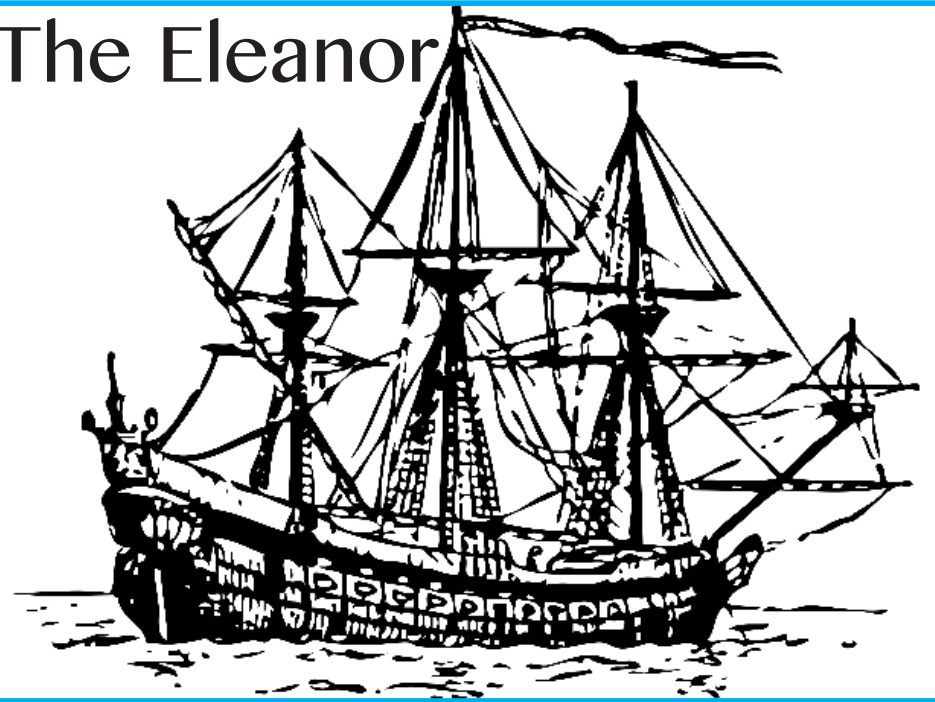
This ship arrived in Boston Harbor on November 28, 1773.

This ship was built in 1767.

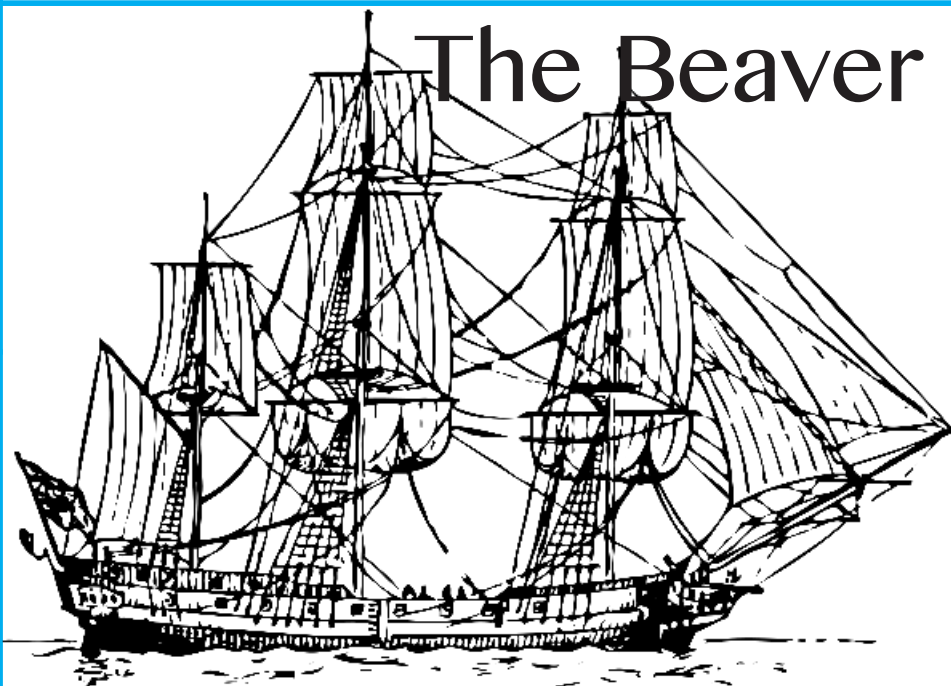
This ship carried 114 chests of tea from the East India Company.
